Summary of the Training

Kannur DDMA had conducted a training program for the officials of the Emergency Operation Centers (EOC) that functions at district and taluk levels. The main objective of the program was to streamline the functions of the district EOC amidst the disaster situations. The district and taluk EOCs working schedule is 24 X 7 modes in both normal and emergency circumstances. The program, as a whole, discussed matters on early warning, introduction to orange book and functions of EOCs and IRS. There were around 100 officials present in the program from police, fire and rescue and revenue departments of different taluks in the district.

The gathering was welcomed by Kannur Disaster Management Deputy Collector Mr. Jayakumar and the introductory speech was given by Dr Sekhar L. Kuriakose, Member Secretary, KSDMA. The training program began with the session on early warning by Mr. Rajeev K, Meteorologist, KSDMA. He explained the topic really well with the data received from various sources including previous disaster situations and also discussed about the actions to be taken if warning were received.

The session of functions and responsibilities of EOCs and introduction to orange book was taken by SEOC hazard analyst, Ms. Amrutha K.
